## HEC CORMIE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The following is the criteria for the selection of two (male-female) athletes for the annual Hec Cormie Scholarship.

- Age 17-21 years
- Have not attained, gained, received selection in an Australian Senior Squad as of November of the previous year of the award
  - Player(s) so selected will be awarded the Scholarship at the Hockey Queensland Annual Award Dinner
  - Have played in at least one National U18 Championship
- In the opinion of the selection panel the player(s) are of excellent character and have a high degree of potential to be selected in the Australian Senior Squad in the future

The selection panel is:  
The Hockey Queensland President  
The QAS Women's Head Coach  
The QAS Men's Head Coach

Both QAS Coaches will confer with their respective senior selectors prior to the formal decision in November.

Once the Scholarship has been awarded the scholarship lasts for 12 months commencing from January to December. Each Scholarship is to the value of \$1500.

### Scholarship Covers:

- Travel and accommodation to State, National, and International camps and tournaments
- Playing equipment including sticks, uniforms, shoes, carry bags and in the case of goal keepers all protective gear
- Registration and insurance fees imposed on the player(s) by their club
  - Training and match fees that may be imposed from time to time
  - Other expenses directly related to playing hockey

(Reimbursement of expenses to the player must be accompanied by receipts)

### Scholarship Does Not Cover

- Vehicle expenses including repairs and maintenance, fuel, registration and insurance
  - Rent for non-tournament accommodation
