What is Hookin2Hockey?

Hook in2 Hockey has undergone some major changes for 2011 making it an even better way to get more children involved in the game than ever before.

2011 Hook in2 Hockey Structure

Hook in2 Hockey now has THREE stages to make delivering a program as easy as 1,2,3!

1. School Stage
An entry level program conducted in schools aimed at 5-8 year olds
2. Community Stage 1
An entry level program conducted at a community venue (club or association) and aimed at 5-8 year olds
3. Community Stage 2
An intermediate level program conducted at a community venue (club or association) and aimed at 9-12 year olds making the transition to junior club hockey

Each stage of Hook in2 Hockey has its own specifically tailored Skill Activities and Skill Games, as laid out in the Coaching Pack, that provide the ideal foundation for developing the skills of the game and having a great time.

Earn your club or association \$\$\$\$\$

Centre's can set their program price at between \$30-\$120 per participant. Centres who choose to set their program price at anything over \$30 per participants can earn revenue for their club or association.

Promotional resources

In 2011 clubs will receive advertising and promotional resources. Including:

- 1000 A5 club/association personalised Hook in2 Hockey flyers
- 20 A3 club/association personalised Hook in2 Hockey posters
- Professionally written press release with specific club details to be inserted.

Online registration

Online Terms & Conditions

By registering your club online you are agreeing to the following Terms and Conditions.

As a registered Hook in2 Hockey Centre, we agree to abide by the following conditions:

- All persons involved in the delivery of Hook in2 Hockey programs are to abide by Hockey Australia's Junior Hockey Policy and Codes of Behaviour as available on the Hockey Australia (HA) website www.hockey.org.au.
- The Centre Hookin2Hockey Coordinator must have a minimum HockeyEd accreditation level of Community Coach.
- Centres must only use HA provided and prepared materials to promote and conduct a Hook in2 Hockey program.
- Centres can not reproduce, without permission from HA, any Hook in2 Hockey materials or resources.
- Centres must conduct a Community program within the following parameters:
 - ratio of one Leader per 12-15 participants,
 - minimum of one (1) and maximum of twelve (12) sessions,
 - sessions of a duration of minimum 45 minutes and maximum 1 ½ hours,
- Each Centre must provide public liability and professional indemnity insurance to cover each program conducted and the volunteer and/or staff members in the course of carrying out his or her duties.
- All Participants, or parents/ guardians thereof if the Participant or Leader is under 18 years of age, must complete and sign the Participant Registration Form online at www.hockey.org.au
- When conducting School Hook in2 Hockey programs Centres may, at their discretion, charge individual participants, and/or the school a delivery fee.
- When conducting Community Hook in2 Hockey programs Centres may charge individuals a participant registration fee of a recommended minimum of \$35.00 and a fixed maximum price of \$120.00 per participant, which must be set at \$5.00 increments.
- Centres will pay HA \$25.00 or \$35.00 per participant from Community programs, being for the Participant Pack, the state/territory association service fee, and the provision of resources from HA.
- As a consequence of registering, each Community program participant will be provided with one of either Hook in2 Hockey Participant Packs as provided by the program's Official Equipment Supplier, Kookaburra Sport:

1. A Goal Pack which includes One fold out backyard hockey goal, A new designed Hookin2 Hockey T-shirt Drink
 2. A Stick pack which includes all of the above plus a Kookaburra stick, shin pads and ball
- Hockey Australia will provide delivery of one consignment of Participant Packs per Community program, per Centre at no cost to the Centre. Each consignment after the initial delivery will incur an additional cost of \$25

How to register your Hookin2Hockey program

1. Logon to www.hockey.org.au/hookin2hockey
2. Click "Get involved"
3. Make sure you understand the Term and Conditions (same as the ones in this booklet)
4. Click on "Register your program online here"
5. Fill in your program details and hit "submit"

Once you have completed all of this and email will be sent to the email noted in your registration from Sportingpulse acknowledging your successful registration.

Please be aware these emails are not automatic only call your State Association if you have not received an email within 2 days after registering.
